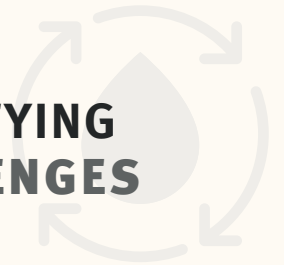

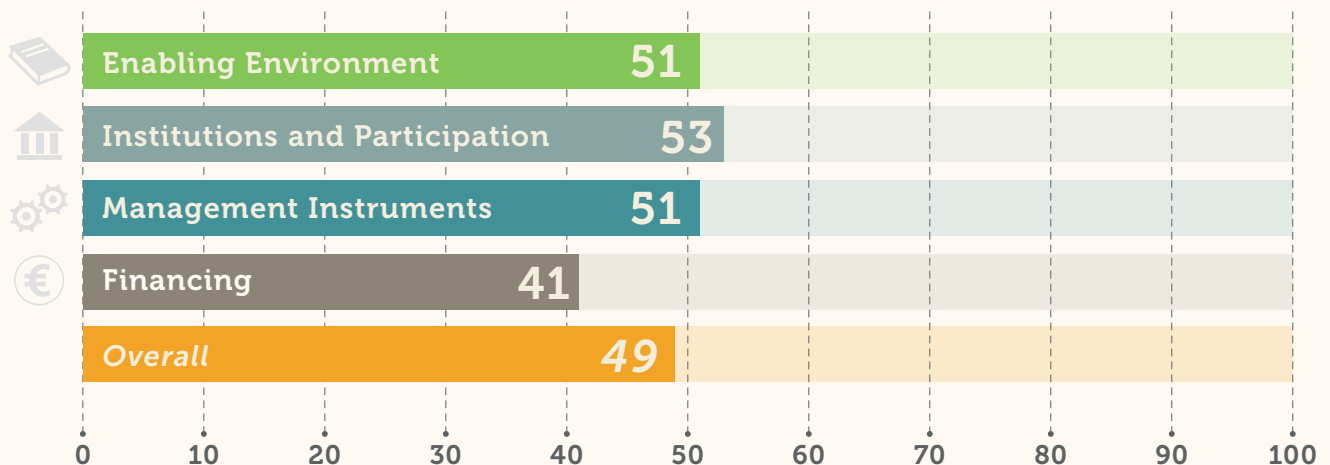

## HOW THE WORLD EVALUATED ITS CURRENT STATUS (2017)



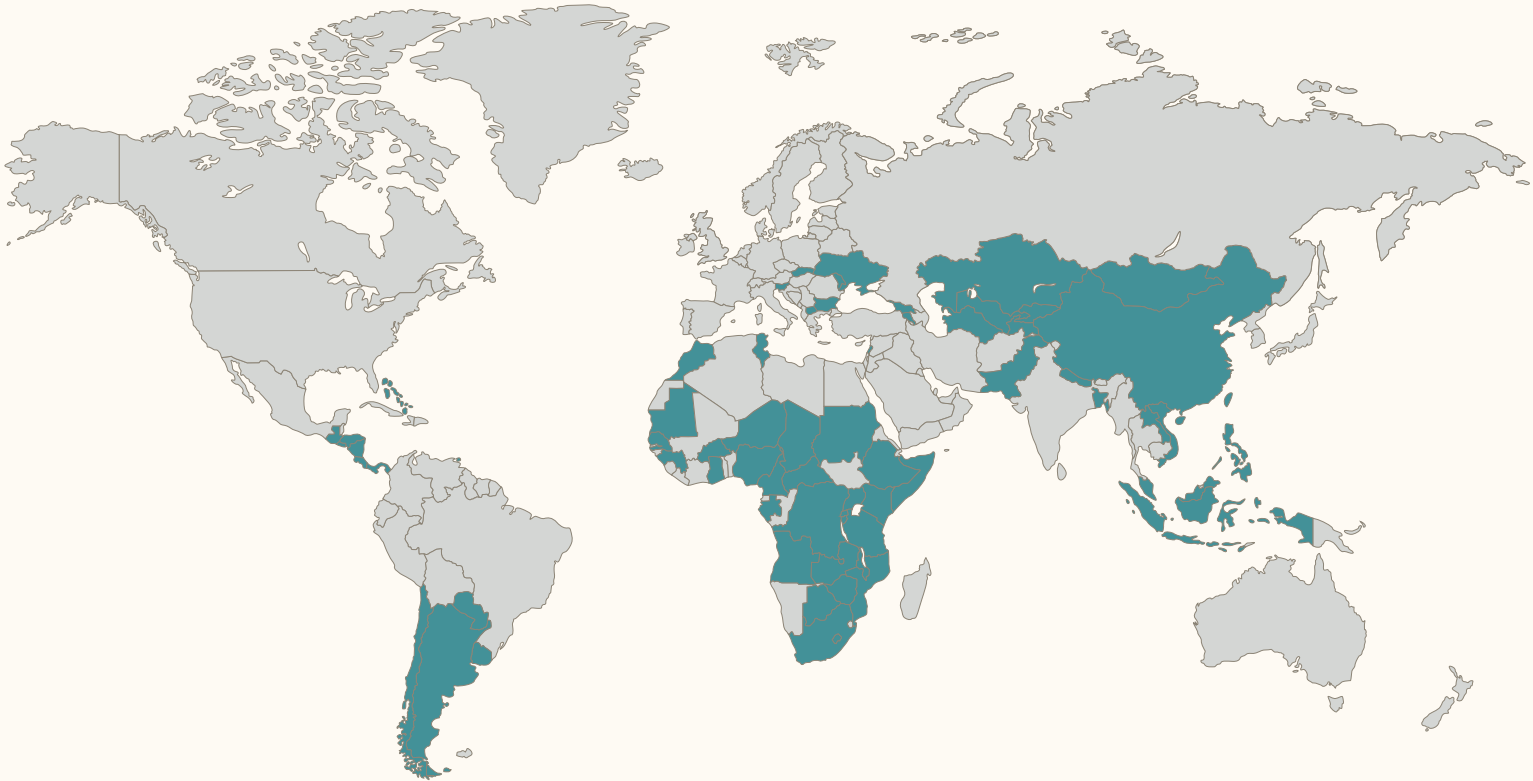

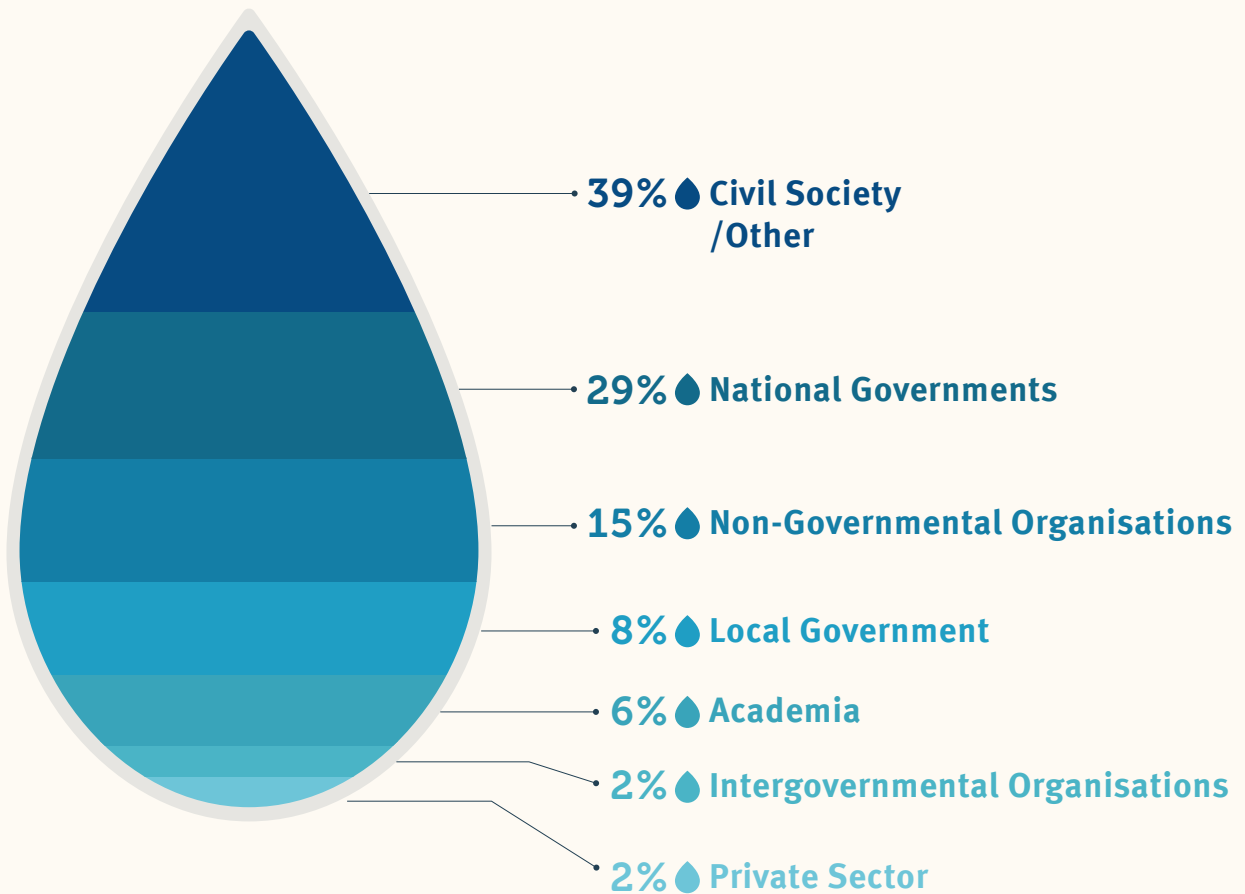


## PARTICIPANTS

In 2020, over **2400 participants** took part in formal consultations on the status of IWRM in **61 countries**, coming from the following stakeholder groups.

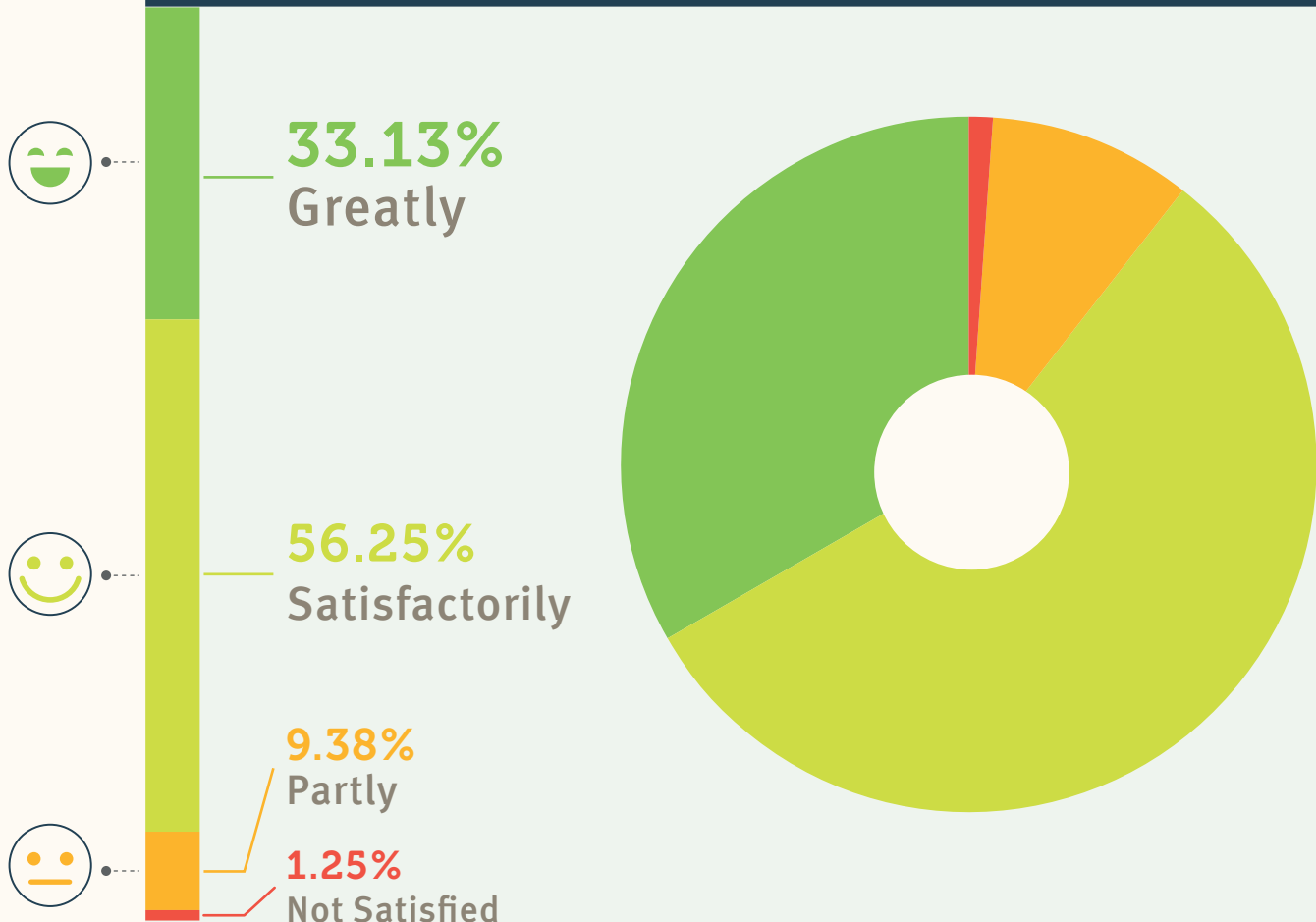




## STAKEHOLDER OPINIONS

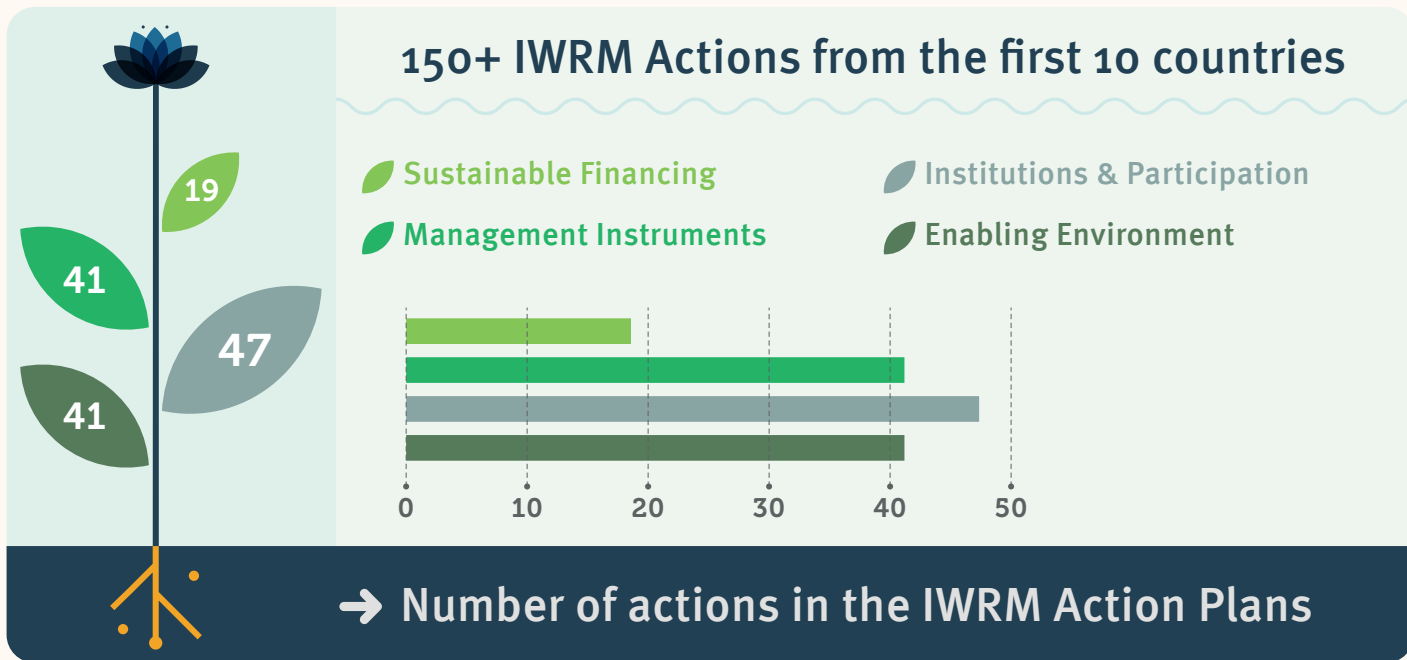
→ How well did the consultations meet the stakeholders' objectives?

Participants were asked how well they felt the consultations on the status of IWRM met their objectives.



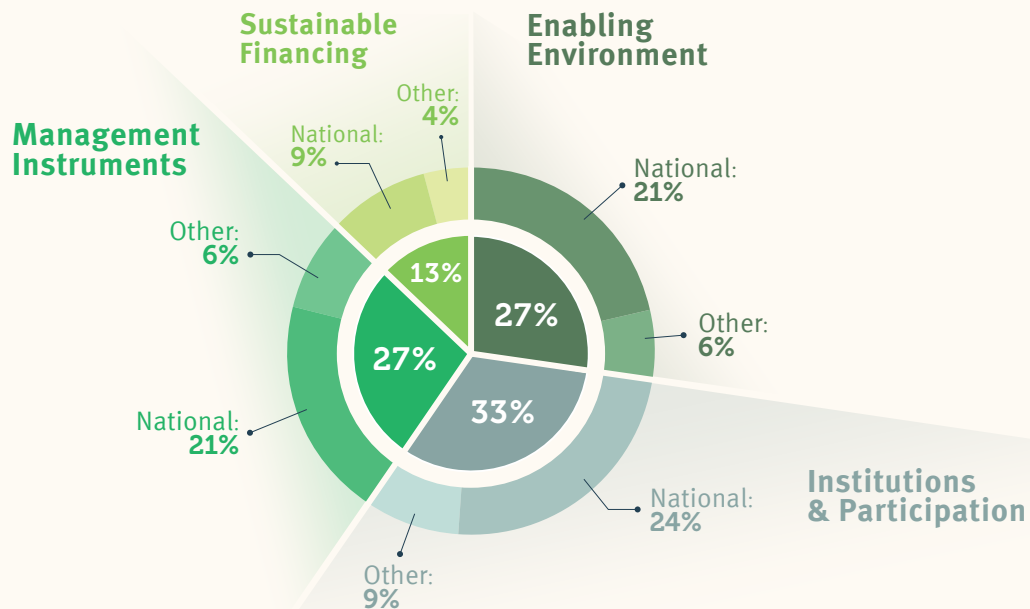

# ACTIONS

Some of the initial pilot actions whose implementation has been supported to move the needle on SDG 6.5.1 include the following:



## Ghana

Improve IWRM implementation in the Pra and Tano basins.



## Honduras

Contribute to the institutionalization of the Water Law.



## Kazakhstan

Support the reform of the state water programme by setting up a scientific-technical council.



## Armenia

Localisation of SDG-6 targets and development of an implementation strategy and monitoring.



## Grenada

Increase public awareness of IWRM by developing and implementing a communication strategy.



## Somalia

Developing capacity and sharing international experiences.
