Context: EU Strategy for the Danube Region (EUSDR)



- One of the EU's four Macro-Regional Strategies
- A framework to address common challenges through cooperation
- Consists of 14 countries (EU member states + candidate countries)
- 12 Priority Areas, covering topics from waterways transport to culture & tourism to biodiversity to security











The Danube Youth Council (DYC) in a nutshell

- A council made up of two young people (18-29 years old) from each Danube Region country → 28 young people in total
- Structure for the institutionalised participation of young people in the EUSDR
- Established as of October 2022
- Members have a mandate of 1 year,
 + option to prolong to a second year

Contribution of young people to the implementation of the Strategy - opportunity for real impact














Role of the DYC

- Serves as an advisory body to the EUSDR stakeholders
- Non-partisan body:
 Members represent not their country, but the voice of their generation
- A framework for meaningful participation















Activities of the DYC (among others)

- participation in EUSDR core governance meetings, to represent the viewpoints of the young generation and provide EUSDR stakeholders with advice and recommendations
- involvement in EUSDR Priority Areas
- active contribution to the EUSDR Annual Forum and other events/conferences
- joint work on specific thematic issues relevant to the Danube Region, e.g. through the publication of papers/essays.













How to apply?

- Application window will open again in July 2025
- Criteria: 18-29 years, residence in one of the 14 Danube Region countries
- Professional background in one of the thematic areas of the EUSDR not a prerequisite
