


HOW DOES GWP INCREASE WATER SECURITY

Managing the world's water resources is foundational to development. Sustainable development will not be achieved without a water secure world. A water secure world integrates a concern for the intrinsic value of water with a concern for its use for human survival and well-being. GWP will hold an interactive seminar on its programmes and projects in 13 regions and 85 countries. The seminar will address the following themes and questions. How can IWRM teaching be embedded in other water related disciplines (e.g. engineering)? What is GWP's approach in Youth and Gender in managing water? A focus on water and climate: how are we working to increase climate resilience?
