STATUS OF SDG 6.5.1

The SDG 6 Integrated Water Resources Management (IWRM) Support Programme assists governments in designing and implementing country-led responses to SDG indicator 6.5.1 on IWRM, as an entry point to accelerate progress towards the achievement of water-related SDGs and other goals in line with national priorities.









Strengthening national monitoring and reporting frameworks on SDG 6.5 on IWRM, identifying critical areas for attention that hinder progress on IWRM at the national level.

Some of the initial pilot actions whose implementation has been supported to move the needle on SDG 6.5.1 include the following:

Ghana

Improve IWRM implementation in the Pra and Tano basins.



Contribute to the institutionalization of the Water Law.

Kazakhstan

Support the reform of the state water programme by setting up a scientific-technical council.



Increase public awareness of IWRM by developing and implementing a communication strategy.

Armenia

Localisation of SDG-6 targets and development of an implementation strategy and monitoring.
