- Be a female and hold citizenship in one of the 85 countries where GWP has a Country Water Partnership (see IWC website or GWP website for the list of relevant countries)
- Have at least two years of experience in the water sector managing **IWRM** projects
- Apply for admission in the IWC Master of Integrated Water Management program and meet the entry requirements:
 - A completed undergraduate degree in a related field of study from an internationally-recognised institution
 - English language proficiency, as demonstrated by an officially recognised test of English language proficiency
