1. For which issues in your region is the water, energy, food security nexus perspective most important? What are the priorities?
2. Where do you see the greatest opportunities for creating synergies by addressing water, energy and food security issues in an integrated way?
3. What are your suggested solutions to address water, energy and food security in a more integrated way? What is needed from government, business and civil society?
 - a. in terms of regulation, other enabling conditions or incentives?
 - b. What roles can a) policy, b) finance and c) technology play?
 - c. What research and capacity development activities do you consider relevant to support a nexus perspective in planning and decision making?
4. Do you know of good examples of how governments/businesses/organizations are addressing water, energy and food security issues in an integrated way and what lessons can be drawn from it?
5. What are good ways to institutionalize the water, energy and food security nexus lens at the local, national as well as international level? What are appropriate organizational forms; how can these be aligned and benefit from already existing institutions?
