ChallengesKey Principles/Approaches of the Proposal

- **Poverty:** (food, energy insecurity, poor access to basic services (eg.Water)
- **High population growth (**young**), urbanization** (unplanned)
- **Poor infrastructure development** (transport, comm., water, energy)
- Inadequate services: education, health, input supply, credit, market
- **Poor capacities** (institutions, policies, community structures) _ governance
- Environmental degradation, climate change
 impacts (drought, floods) water scarcity-70%
 IGAD is ASALs, deforestation, poor agri.l
 practices, conflicts, encroaching vital
 ecosystems/marginal

- Better management of water resources is important for food/energy security and sustaining ecosystems
- Sectoral processes (Policies, Strategies, Investment programs/Projects) need to be seen from the NEXUS perspective
- Recognize the complexities related to multisectoral (water, food, energy, ecosystems) and geographical (local, national and regional) interactions for the NEXUS approach
- promote that water for agriculture is secured by considering other uses &users (sectors)
- Promote for a common objective of NEXUS approach in the region—IGAD declaration on the approach, linked to IGAD Regional CAADP, IDDRSI, political ownership
- Promote cooperation between countries sharing water, ecosystems (forest, wetland,..)

- Linkage or building on on-going initiatives—IDDRSI, Water Program, Food Security
- Facilitate Investment
- Working beyond sectors—multi-stakeolder process
- Innovative approaches: Su, Eth, Ug—water allocation tools (economic, socila and environmental), enhancing supplies and managing demands
- Collaboration between key sectors (Agriculture, Water, DRM, Environment/Climate) both at country and regional levels
- Establish/use existing Platforms for Regional NEXUS Dialogue
- Establish/use existing Platforms for Country NEXUS Dialogue
- Assess opportunities (Policy/Strategy review processes, Investment Planning, Programs/Project design processes, etc) to promote the NEXUS approach
- Framework analysis for NEXUS approach at national and regional level
- Demonstrate innovative Nexus approaches that will contribute to food security.
