GWP CACENA in November 2005

Completed works under the regional report "Gender Aspects of Integrated Water Resources Management in the Countries of Central Asia and Caucasus". The Russian version prepared for publication and presentation to the GWP CACENA Stakeholders Conference which will be held in Tashkent on 8-9 December. The English version will be published in January 2006. The report stated that gender aspects do have the certain positive potential for improving water resources management and promoting efficiency of water use. Executors of this assignment are sure that presented findings of the gender surveys in all eight countries of Central Asia and Caucasus (by the example of representative districts in rural areas) can help decision-makers, financial agencies, and water professionals to mobilize this earlier ulterior potential for putting it into real practice.
