



## Green Climate Fund – at a glance


- The GCF is the world's largest dedicated fund helping developing countries in responding to climate change.
  - It was set up by the UNFCCC in 2010.
- The aim of all GCF activities is to support developing countries limiting or reducing their GHG emissions and adapt to climate change impacts.
- The GCF has a crucial role in serving the Paris Agreement, supporting the goal of keeping average global temperature rise well below 2° C.
- It does this by channelling climate finance to developing countries, which have joined other nations in committing to climate action.
  - Pledged funding: USD 10.3 billion
  - Disbursement goal: USD 2.5 billion by 2020
- Access through Accredited Entities (AE) after approval of the national designated authority (NDA) or focal point (FP).





#### NDA in Albania

**NDAs** are government institutions that serve as the **interface between each country and the GCF**.

The NDA in Albania is nominated in 2016 by the Ministry of Tourism and Environment.

The Focal Point in Albania is Deputy Minister, Ornela Cuci

Core functions of NDA and FP:



Communicates with the secretariat



Facilitates visits and meetings, nomination of NIEs and national stakeholder engagement



Develop a strategic country work programme

## **Progress of CP in Albania**

The Country Program for Albania is a document that serves to bring Albania's climate change aspirations to life by identifying short- and medium-term projects / programs and investments.

The National Program for Albania is divided into 3 sections:

#### **Section A**

Provides a brief overview of Albania's problems and threats arising from or related to climate change categorized by strategic sectors.

#### Section B

Presents project identification / programs or concepts that are being implemented nationally that address measures to adapt and mitigate climate change in Albania.

#### Section C

Analyzes Albania's commitment to the GCF and identifies, referring to national sectorial strategies, potential projects that need to be financed by the GCF to ensure the achievement of Albania's envisaged objectives.



## **Country Programme Drafting Process**



Stakeholder meetings with various groups of stakeholders such as:

- Relevant ministries;
- National governmental agencies;
- National and International NGOs;
- Universities; and,
- Private sector;



#### Desk work by:

- Revising existing plans and strategies;
- Analysing national objectives and commitments;
- Etc.;

## Applied methodology for pre-screening

#### Screening Tool for Project Ideas considers:

- General GCF eligibility criteria
- Financial information provided
- GCF investment criteria

#### Key evaluation parameters:

- Scope and results area of the planned activity
- Size of the planned activity
- Ranking against the six investment criteria



#### **General Evaluation Results**

#### Portfolio Findings:

- -34 screened project ideas in total
- -13 project ideas recommended for alternative funding channels
- -21 eligible for GCF: 4 adaptation, 7 cross-cutting, 10 mitigation
- -Energy efficiency improvements in public buildings: 6
- -Climate resilient agriculture: 2
- -Adapted water management: 7
- -Green Cities: 3
- -Forestry: 4

#### **General Characteristics:**

- -Volume/Size: Varies from
- -USD 3,000 to USD 200 million
- -14 indicate already an Accredited Entitiy
- -Co-financing ratio: varies from 0% to 88%






