NEMA Accreditation Credentials

- Micro-scale, project size of US\$ 10 million irrespective of the size of the GCF contribution. Can submit as many proposals but with 10 USD capping
- Category B
- Project management
- Full grants; No conditional need for co-finance or leveraged finance

COORDINATION MECHANISM

- 1. GCF Programme design process for NEMA, steered by National treasury and in their role as NDA and NEMA as the Accredited Entity
- 2. Process Conceived through a consultative process mainly with NDA, NIE NEMA and MENR, With and technical support from from CDKN, WRI, UNEP
- 3. Formation of a three tier governance structure to oversee the programme design

Governance (Coordination)



1. Project Steering Committee.

Role: Steer the programme, highest decision making organ

- 1. Convened and Chaired by the National Treasury and co-chaired by the Ministry of Environment
- 2. Membership; Treasury, MENR, NEMA, CDKN, LTS, COG, All readiness providers

2. Technical Working Group

Role: Give technical guidance to the process, eg Identification of the priority thematic areas

- 3: Project Design Teams: PDTs; Design the projects
- 1. Selection process of PDTs Letters for nomination from the National Treasury were sent to PSs and CEOs of MDAs
- 2. PDTs have received training on GCF processes, Adaptation Project prioritisation and Financial and Economic analysis
- 3. Institutions represented; MOA, MENR, Ministry of Devolution, NDMA, Council of Governors, UON, KEFRI, KFS, KARLO, KEPSA, Ministry of Water, World Concern, WWF, NEMA, WARMA
