Working within the Hydro-informatics Division, the Senior Database Administrator will be responsible for maintaining IWMI's database systems, including backup, performance tuning, capacity planning, monitoring critical events and documentation.

The Senior Database Administrator will be responsible for overall database design, implementation and operations on the Extraction, Transformation and Loading (ETL) pipeline, and feeding data into the central repository; and implementation and administration of database servers. The position is also responsible for ensuring requirements; monitoring and optimizing the performance of the databases; and supporting application developers with database operations, including the development of complex SQL queries, tuning of DML.

Candidates with a bachelor's or master's degree in computer science or equivalent educational qualifications, relevant experience and an excellent background in database administration, with a high level of computer literacy and a strong understanding of computer programming tools, are encouraged to apply.
