



Sri Lanka Water Partnership marked the World Water Day on 22 March 2014

Sri Lanka Water Partnership (SLWP) in collaboration with Irrigation Management Division of the Ministry of Irrigation conducted a series of awareness raising activities at Nuwarawewa, Anurahadhapura in the North Central Province of Sri Lanka focusing on the adversities of the climate change in the area. The event consisted of an advocacy walk, a street drama and a Shramadana (a community welfare activity).

More than 200 participants mainly the farmers and farmer leaders who attended the walk wear the t-shirts with Jalaya Jeewayai (water is the life) message. The walk was followed by the street drama in the middle of the town which was full of important messages related to water-related issues in the area.
